2. Complete your registration.

Your online account is your gateway for taking care of registration, payment, and extra details. The following items are due 45 days before the program, June 21:

• Full payment.

• Liability Waivers.

• The week or so before the program you will receive your **SLU Journey Box** in the mail. Scan the QR code on the box before you open it!

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What's included in the SLU 101 Vision Experience?

1. Your very own "SLU Journey Box"

- Contains a variety of activities, visual aids and resources.
- Is designed to facilitate problem-solving, imagination, discovery, and analysis of the content being consumed through the leadership development journey.
- Each session will contain something tangible that will encourage and accompany the student in growing in their leadership. In other words, everything about **SLU 101 Vision** is completely hands-on!

2. An engaging virtual platform

- SLU 101 core sessions are condensed and highly creative.
- Designed to guide the student through the "SLU Journey Box," thus meeting the student in their physical context and allowing them to drive their own learning process.

3. A Communal Spirit

- Students will be able to interact and ask questions of the presenters.
- There will be an opportunity for students to connect with each other, interact, and learn together.

What are the age requirements for SLU 101 Vision?

To attend as a single, a student must be at least 15 years old. To attend with a group, students should be at least 14 years old and in the 8th grade.

How will I access the conference online?

Information and a link to access the stream will be sent to the email with which you registered at least one week prior to the event.

Should I dress for success?

To set yourself up for success, we recommend that you attend this conference just as you would if you were attending in person at a nice hotel. You will not be shown in the video at any time, but we believe the way you dress does reflect how serious you will take yourself and this learning journey.

What is in the SLU 101 Vision Journey Box?

A customized "SLU Journey Box" will contain a variety of activities, visual aids and games designed to facilitate problem-solving, imagination, discovery, and analyzing the content being consumed through the leadership development journey. Our sessions will contain something tangible that will encourage and accompany the student in growing in their leadership.

What materials should I have at my "at home" workstation?

We recommend having a computer or laptop with a good internet connection to view the conference, a Bible, a pen or pencil to take notes (syllabus will be provided), a space to watch the conference (we suggest designating one space for these two days), and a credit card if you want to purchase resources/merch from the SLU online store.

What if I am a group leader and want my group to attend together?

You are welcome to gather together and view sessions together with other registered attendees! Either way, we recommend debriefing sessions as a group at the end of each day. This can be accomplished on your own via video chat or by gathering together.

Can I pay for one registration and then watch it with a group?

There will be individualized access codes/links sent out with one-time logins and will not be valid for multiple users. Only the person registered will be eligible to move on to the next level of the SLU.

Will I be able to go back and watch the content later?

This conference is LIVE with interactive components such as a Q & A time with the speaker just as if you were attending our SLU 101 Dream in a ballroom setting. Therefore, sessions will not be available once the conference concludes.



Can I leave the session and come back in?

Session content will be live, so you can leave and come back but you will miss that portion of the conference (just like if you were to leave a ballroom and come back). There will not be the option to pause or rewind.

How does the chat feature work?

The chat feature in the SLU 101 Vision experience is provided for the purpose of positive and uplifting interaction among participants, speakers and SLU staff. The chat is limited to registered SLU 101 Vision attendees but is also global to the community, meaning that all SLU 101 Vision participants can view all content posted within the chat. Any misuse of the chat in a manner that is found offensive, disrespectful or distracting will result in removal of chat privileges. By attending this program, you agree to the guidelines below.

Chat Guidelines:

Respect Others – All participants within the chat are expected to conduct themselves in a respectful manner at all times.

- Harassment, defamation, or slandering of individuals or groups is not permitted and will result in immediate removal from the chat and possibly the SLU 101 Vision program.
- Refrain from using or referring to any subject that could be found offensive to another member of the chat.
- During a session, please limit the conversation to content that is specific to the lesson being presented.
- Distracting and irrelevant conversations are not permitted at any time.
- Appropriate, respectful and uplifting language should be used at all times.
- Respect for authority figures, local and national officials and all other individuals is expected at all times.

Be Helpful and Supportive - We encourage participants to connect and support one another as we go through this journey together.

- Questions posted in the chat should be relevant and posed in a respectful manner.
- Refrain from sharing personal information about yourself or others (i.e., birthdays, cell phone numbers, social media handles, etc.)
- Attendees must use the name they were registered with for their profile and to interact in the chat. Impersonating others is prohibited and will result in immediate removal from the chat and possibly the SLU 101 Vision program.
- Links, websites, etc. may not be posted by an attendee.

How do I earn a scholarship to attend Charleston Southern University by attending SLU?

All graduates of SLU 101 who meet CSU's admission standards, and are full-time freshmen are eligible to receive a scholarship of \$2,000 per year for 4 years. Students must have attended SLU prior to enrollment at CSU. Confirmation of completion is required for the initial award.

How does CSU receive confirmation of completion of SLU 101?

Once you complete SLU 101, we will send your name directly to CSU's admissions office. There is no need for you to do anything to confirm your SLU 101 attendance.

What is the transfer and cancellation policy for SLU Vision?

- Cancellations 45 days or more before event: Deposit will be lost
- Cancellations Less than 45 days before the event: 100% of the total cost of the program will be forfeited.
- Transfer Policy: Transfers for this program will not be allowed 30 days or less before the program begins due to the resources that will be mailed to attendees.
