EVENT OVERVIEW

Youth Pastor Summit is a two-day conference that brings together student pastors, educators, and volunteers into one room to foster **collaboration**, **community**, and **soul-care**. It is a direct response to the growing need for people to pour into this generation.

YPS gathers thousands of leaders from across their regions of the country from 30+ denominations and movements. Each YPS includes mainstage sessions and leadership labs. This year, we will host spring YPS events in SoCal, Dallas, Nashville, and Raleigh and introduce the first ever YPS National in Orlando, Florida this fall.

We bring in some of the world's best student ministry minds, communicators, and practitioners to address four foundational and ever-present questions:

- 3. Ethics: How should we think?
- 4. **Leadership**: Why and how do we influence?

Youth Pastor Summit is geared to all youth pastors and key youth leaders (staff or volunteers). It is also open to Christian educators. *All attendees must be 18 years or older*.

Can I transfer my ticket to someone else?
