EVENT OVERVIEW

Youth Pastor Summit is a two-day conference that brings together student pastors, educators, and volunteers into one room to foster **collaboration, community**, and **soul-care**. It is a direct response to the growing need for people to pour into this generation.

As Student Leadership University trains up the next generation, we increasingly recognize the exponential impact that the leaders have on these students. YPS gathers thousands of leaders from across their regions of the country from 30+ denominations and movements. Each YPS includes mainstage sessions and leadership labs. This year, we will host spring YPS events in SoCal, Dallas, Nashville, and Raleigh and introduce the first ever YPS National in Orlando, Florida this fall.

We bring in some of the world's best student ministry minds, communicators, and practitioners to address four foundational and ever-present questions:

- 1. Spiritual Formation: Who are we becoming?
- 2. God's Mission: What story is God telling?
- 3. Ethics: How should we think?
- 4. Leadership: Why and how do we influence?

Important Parking Notes: Let's Be Good Neighbors!

We are so excited to have you join us for YPS Raleigh, at Seven Marks Church. As we prepare to welcome you, we kindly ask that you review the following **parking guidelines** to help us be respectful neighbors and ensure a smooth experience for everyone (the church is located in a busy shopping area). We also suggest that you allow for extra time to find a parking spot and if you can carpool with your team, that would be great!

- 1. **Please avoid parking at the surrounding banks or across the street**, especially the Wells Fargo lot, as these spaces are not affiliated with the church and are needed for regular business operations.
- 2. You may park in front of the building, but please be mindful to avoid the clearly marked spots designated for KlayStation and The Teach Me Store, the church's neighboring businesses in the same complex.
- 3. Additional parking is available:
 - *Behind the church building* in both the upper and lower lots, including along the grass berm— double parking is permitted along the side of the building if needed.
 - In "the Square," the lot directly behind Wells Fargo (accessed via Leigh Drive). Please park around the perimeter and leave the center open for the taco truck that operates there.
 - *Along Leigh Drive* itself, which has wide and accessible curbside parking.
 - At Home Depot, located just behind Seven Marks Church.

What to Pack: Make sure to pack a pen, notebook & a bottle of water for you to have during the conference.

<u>Meals</u>: Dinner on Monday is on your own. Take advantage of restaurants close to the church as traffic could get bad around 5, and you will want to make it back in time our evening session! Lunch will be provided on Tuesday. Make sure to stop by our sponsor tables and say thanks!

Who should attend YPS?

Youth Pastor Summit is geared to all youth pastors and key youth leaders (staff or volunteers). It is also open to Christian educators. *All attendees must be 18 years or older*.

Can my spouse attend?

I have a small child; can they attend with me?

We want everyone to have the best experience possible at this event, so please make arrangements to leave your children at home or arrange childcare outside of the conference.

Can I transfer my ticket to someone else?

If you are registered as a group, we will do a one-time transfer of any of your participants, without penalty. Transfers are not available on individual registrations. This one-time transfer must occur a minimum of ten business days before the event.
