Program Coordinator Role Responsibilities:

- Work with SLU Programs Team to lead coordination of assigned SLU programs and Youth Pastor Summit (YPS) events (8–9 SLU, 5–6 YPS events per year).
- Assist with program logistics and administrative tasks, including registration, materials, and communication.
- Serve on-site at events as a key logistical and relational point person.
- Assist with event budgets, coordinate volunteer staff, and handle vendor and speaker logistics.

Marketing Coordinator Role Responsibilities:

- Work alongside SLU Creative Team to help manage and grow SLU's social media presence and engagement strategies.
- Serve as a bridge with both creative and programs team to create event keynotes, maintain Planning Center, and event production.
- Ensure SLU's website and registration platforms are maintained with updated information.
- Support with design and distribution of merchandise and SLU store items for ministry and events.
- Assist in creating quick-turn graphics used in marketing efforts like social media, emails, and promotional print pieces.

What You Bring to the Position:

- **Bachelor's degree** in Hospitality, Event Management, Marketing, Communications or a related field (preferred).
- Strong **organizational and time-management** skills; ability to manage multiple projects and meet deadlines.
- Excellent **communication skills**, both verbal and written.
- Proficiency with **Microsoft Office (especially Excel), Keynote, Adobe Suite (InDesign, Photoshop, Illustrator)** and **Mac OS**.
- A **servant-leader heart**, self-starter mindset, and team-first attitude.
